

Bristol Tree Forum Submission

To the Draft Local Plan Review

The new Local Plan proposals as they relate to trees

The [Draft Local Plan Review](#) confirms that BCS9, DM15 and DM17 are ‘proposed to be retained’ (para. 10.22). BCS11 is renamed **Draft Policy IDC1: Development contributions and CIL**, but repeats BCS11 verbatim.

There are other policies which, indirectly, also affect the status of trees in Bristol’s urban forest: **Policy DM19: Development and Nature Conservation** and **Policy DM21: Development of Private Gardens**. These will also be retained.

On the face of it, it looks as if tree protection policies and developers’ obligations to replace lost trees are to be retained. However, *DM15* summarises the position (our underlining) as ‘Trees should be provided - range of circumstances and settings when they should be sought’ and *DM17* states (our underlining) ‘Where some loss of trees cannot be avoided, the policy requires their replacement, generally in greater numbers’.

Our submission

We are pleased that plans are in place to carry over almost verbatim the policies from the current Local Plan as they relate to trees and green spaces, but we would like the proposed new policies to keep the strong wording found in the current policies.

We are concerned at a weakening in the wording in the current drafts, which developers could use to suggest that they have discretion in complying with tree protection requirements and tree-loss mitigation policies, or that there may be ways of persuading Council Officers not to enforce them or to dilute them. These should be amended to ensure that this cannot happen. With this in mind, we recommend the following amendments (underlined):

Redraft **Policy IDC1** as ‘Trees ~~should~~ will be provided...range of circumstances and settings when they ~~should~~ will be sought’.

Redraft **Policy DM17** as ‘Where some loss of trees cannot be avoided, the policy requires their replacement, ~~and generally~~. This replacement will be in accordance with the Bristol Tree Replacement Standard.’

Policy DM15 should also be amended to require developers to include tree planting proposals in their landscape plans.

We are also pleased that the current Bristol Tree Replacement Standard (BTRS) in *DM17* will be retained. We understand it has been used as a model by other local authorities more widely across the UK and has been recommended by the [Trees and Design Action Group](#). We applaud its inclusion as an important part of the Council’s planning strategy.

However, decisions about the implementation of BTRS which have evolved since its inception suggest that the policy needs to be clarified. We propose the following changes:

- 1) Each of the replacement trees chosen will have the potential to achieve, at maturity, a size equivalent to the tree lost.
- 2) If there are no suitable planting sites on or close to the development site (usually within a one-mile radius), then planting sites further afield within the boundary of the city may be selected.
- 3) Subject to the above, the selection of species and the off-site planting site will be at the discretion of the Council in consultation with local community groups.
- 4) Proposals to plant hedging to replace lost trees will not be acceptable.
- 5) BTRS will be applied where trees have been felled within the last two years before the planning application.
- 6) Developers will be obliged to replace or re-fund the replacement of trees planted under BTRS where those trees have died within two years of the trees being planted.
- 7) BTRS replacement trees should be standards of a size and quality equivalent to those planted by the Council as street trees.
- 8) BTRS will apply to Bristol City Council whenever a tree is removed by it for reasons other than tree management.

Bristol has achieved an enviable reputation amongst local authorities for having robust tree policies, deservedly so. We would like to see these policies retained, clarified and strengthened.

While BTRS goes some way to mitigate the loss of trees due to development, neither it nor the Council's [TreeBristol](#) sponsorship scheme (which covers the replacement of trees lost in the normal management cycle) can do anything to increase Bristol's urban forest as they mostly only replace lost trees.

This issue has further been exacerbated by the practice which has recently evolved of using Section 106 funds set aside specifically to replace trees lost to development to plant trees in sites where existing trees have been felled and made available by TreeBristol for sponsorship. In effect, one tree is being planted where two have been lost!

Furthermore a tree that could have been replaced by a sponsor for £295 is being planted at the BTRS price of £765.21, so the Council is 'pocketing' the spare maintenance cost of £470.21 (the difference between £765.21 and £295) set aside for a S106 tree that will never be planted. This is because the sponsorship site already has its maintenance cost assigned. This anomaly needs to be resolved.

The consequence of all this is that we have seen a decline in Bristol's tree canopy cover over the years. The Council needs to develop policies to reverse this trend. The draft Local Plan does not do so.

If anything, the current proposals threaten to reduce the space available for tree planting within the city without making any counterproposals for compensatory open space allocation or for further tree planting. For example, it is proposed to rezone some open spaces for housing and related development by:

- 1) Removing significant parts of the City's 596 hectares of Green Belt land. See the [Local Plan Review - Draft Policies and Development Allocations](#) (pp. 43-47).
- 2) Re-zoning local open spaces. See for example, in [Bristol Local Plan Review Annex - Draft Development Allocations](#):
 - a) BDA0601 - Land at Latimer Close, Brislington East ward (p. 36)
 - b) BDA0702 - Land at Marmalade Lane (south), Brislington West ward (p. 38)
 - c) BDA1501 - Land at College Road, Fishponds, Frome Vale ward, (p. 74)
 - d) BDA2901 - Land at Lanercost Road, Southmead ward (p. 132)).
- 3) Plans to 'Infill' open spaces in residential areas. See for example in [Bristol Local Plan Review Draft Policies and Development Allocations](#) at **Draft Policy DS14: Central Southmead**, which proposes developing Glencoyne Square for housing (p. 51).

The recent [Bristol One City Plan](#) makes a commitment to double tree canopy cover to 24% by 2046. With a council land area of 10,970 hectares, this is equivalent to planting some 1,316 hectares of new trees over the next 25 years (that's nearly 53 hectares per annum). We calculate that there are probably only about 2,500 hectares of Open Space and Green Belt land available across the city, much of it already planted to capacity with trees.

Even the Council's flagship [One Tree Per Child](#) scheme (the only city-wide scheme available to increase Bristol's tree cover) has probably only added, at best, about 12 hectares of new trees since its inception in 2013/14. Adding, say, another 6,000 trees p.a. for the next 25 years (at, say, 20.0 square metres added canopy cover per tree at maturity) would add (eventually) only another 300 hectares of new trees, or about 23% of the Bristol One City Plan commitment.

Given the Bristol One City Plan commitment, the recent declaration of a climate emergency both locally and nationally, and the recommendation that we plant 3 billion trees nationally to help mitigate the impacts of climate change, the absence of any new planning policies to help achieve these goals is surprising.

Bristol Local Plan Review - New Protection for Open Space

The [Bristol Local Plan Review](#) identifies 168 Local Green Space (LGS) sites and 422 Reserved Open Space (ROS) sites. We do not plan to comment on whether particular designations are appropriate or not, though some designations (and non-designations) are hard to understand. We invite the Council to consult further with local communities and community groups (including us) about these proposed designations and other undesignated sites.

Our interest is because these sites (along with many others which have not been designated) offer potential for new tree planting.

We do have some questions and observations, however:

- 9) What sites previously designated as 'Important Open Spaces' or 'Unidentified Open Spaces' listed in the Current Local Plan, have been omitted from the Local Plan Review?
- 10) Why have many potential Open Space sites been omitted?

[Appendix One](#) lists 328 Open Spaces (there are likely to be more) which have neither an LGS nor an ROS category, but which could potentially be given either

designation. It would have been helpful if this review had identified these and any other sites the Council is aware of, giving reasons why no designation has been made.

- 11) What will the status of Open Space sites not granted LGS or ROS status be?
- 12) Why have 31 Railway land sites been designated as ROS? ROS12010, ROS12011 & ROS12012 appear to have been lost to new rail infrastructure.
- 13) Why are only some sites in Green Belt and Neighbourhood Planning Areas given an LGS designation (LGS05001, the three allotments incorporated into LGS05002, and LGS31003) while others are not? For example, these sites have no designation:
 - a) The privately-owned woodland in St George Troopers Hill ward to the south of LGS29003
 - b) Dundridge Farm Playing Fields in St George Troopers Hill ward
 - c) The Bath Road Allotments in Brislington West ward
 - d) Three sites in Southville ward - Kennel Lodge 1 & 2 and Bower Ashton allotments
 - e) We have identified 10 more sites owned by the Council (including those parts of Ashton Court which fall within the city boundary) which might reasonably be so designated.

The Local Plan Review recognises that the National Planning Practice Guidance permits such designations as *'a way to provide special protection against development for green areas of particular importance to local communities.'* This is particularly important in the case of the Bath Road Statutory Allotments, where it is proposed that the land around will be developed.

- 14) Why has the river Avon (or its banks) flowing within the boundaries of the city not been given either LGS or ROS status? Only part of it is in Green Belt.
- 15) The last paragraph of the **Reserved Open Space** policy text refers to 'Local Green Space' (p.9). Is this intentional?
- 16) The plan also states at page 9: 'Neighbourhood Plans [NPA] in the city include their own designations of Local Green Space. This Local Plan review does not make further proposals for Local Green Space designations within the boundaries of those plans.' This is not correct. We have identified these LGS sites in:
 - a) Knowle West NPA - LGS14001, LGS14002 & LGS22003
 - b) Lawrence Weston NPA - LGS02002
 - c) Lockleaze NPA - LGS24003, LGS24004, LGS24005 & LGS24006
 - d) Redcliffe NPA - LGS08002, LGS08004 & LGS08005.

In some cases, these sites may cross NPA boundaries.

- 17) The Bristol-wide map at page 33 shows only three of the six NPAs. Why is this?
- 18) At **Stage 1 Collating inputs, para 3.6** (p. 11) it states 'In accordance with national policy, open spaces already designated through Neighbourhood Plan Areas within Hengrove, Hartcliffe, Lawrence Weston and Old Market were not appraised further. These areas are therefore excluded from the mapping shown in Appendix 2.' It would have been helpful had these sites been identified.
